

# CHAPERONE EXPECTATIONS AGREEMENT

\*\*Chaperones are expected to be available for supervision from the time the students board the bus to begin the trip until the students exit the bus at the conclusion of the trip. In taking on the responsibility of being a chaperone, you agreed to:

## Be the eyes and ears for the Head Coach or Sponsor.

Help enforce the expectations we have set for the students. Don't hesitate to address students on any inappropriate or unsafe behavior. If you have to address a student on any inappropriate behavior, please contact a member of the coaching staff/sponsor and tell them about the incident. Report any injuries to the Head Coach/Sponsor immediately. For serious injuries or accidents please call 911.

#### Be responsible for your group.

Each chaperone will be responsible for their assigned students; who you will meet at the beginning of the trip. Make sure you know the whereabouts of your students at all times. If the students desire to leave the hotel or activity area during their downtime, make sure you or another chaperone accompany them. You are also expected to stay awake at least 1 ½ hours past the bed check time for all of the students in your group and to make sure no students from other rooms come into your students' room after the bed check nor that your students leave their room after the bed check.

### Be a positive role model for all of the students on the trip.

Show your enthusiasm for the team or activities. As a chaperone, your attitude can have a dramatic impact on the overall tone of the trip. Being a positive role model also includes setting a good example, *therefore*, *absolutely no alcohol*, *drugs*, *inappropriate language or gambling will be allowed during the trip*. Use the Pursuing Victory with Honor principles as a guide.

## • Encourage inclusive rather than exclusive behavior

When else do your students have a chance to network with so many other youth with a shared interest? Encourage your students to mix and mingle and have a positive attitude with other teams or activity groups on the trip; which is part of our trip justification.

Be available to help the Head Coach or Sponsor as needed.
