The SNAP Parent Portal is an integral part of the new electronic health record (EHR) system. This system helps keep student health information safe and organized. The Parent Portal, which was rolled out in March 2025, makes it easier for parents to share important health information about their child and communicate with school health staff.

- Upload healthcare provider orders and vaccination records.
- Direct message with the healthcare team at your school.
- Receive health-related announcements.
