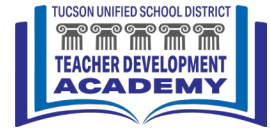

Please note: As part of the application process, upon passing an initial screener, applicants will be required to participate in an in-person interview.

Minimum Requirements:

- Hold a bachelor's degree.
- Willingness to teach in Kindergarten-5th grade (participant's choice).
- Ability to attend evening classes from 5-7 pm for the next two years (2-3 times monthly).
- Ability to begin teaching/learning on July 15, 2025.
- Ability to teach in a TUSD school for a minimum of 4 years (2-year commitment after program completion).

- Two letters of recommendation:
 - One from an employer/supervisor.
 - One professional recommendation.
- Completion of essays (see below for details).

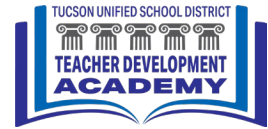

Personal Essay Requirement:

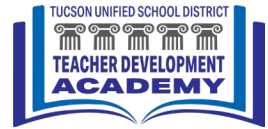
Applicants must complete the following five essays on a separate typed document. These essays provide an opportunity to describe your passion for education, personal achievements, strengths, and what makes you a unique candidate. Please note that these essays are weighted and may impact your progression in the application process.

Written Application Essay Questions:

- 1. Interest and Unique Qualifications:** (Weight: 30%)
Why are you interested in participating in the Teacher Development Academy, and what sets you apart from other candidates? Describe your professional aspirations, any K-12 or higher educational activities, and experiences working with children.
- 2. Adaptability and Learning:** (Weight: 30%)
Teaching often requires significant time commitments, including late nights or weekends. Can you provide an example from your previous career where you had to manage a demanding workload or make sacrifices to achieve a goal? How do you plan to balance these demands with the responsibilities of being a teacher?
- 3. Passion for Education:** (Weight: 20%)
What aspect of teaching are you most passionate about, and why? How do you plan to inspire and engage students with that passion?
- 4. Collaboration and Seeking Help:** (Weight: 10%)
Describe a project from your previous career where you worked as part of a team. How will you foster a collaborative environment among your colleagues and students in a school setting? Additionally, how would you approach seeking help and support when facing challenges in teaching?
- 5. Reflective Practice:** (Weight: 10%)
Reflect on a challenge you faced in your previous career and how you overcame it. How will you apply this reflective practice to continuously improve your teaching methods?
